Key Areas of Learning

As Geographers we will learn to use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of our school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of the surrounding environment.

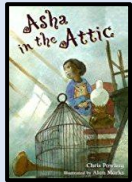
As Historians we will create our own timeline and learn about historical events, people and places within our own locality.

As Artists we will create portraits in the style of Picasso, learning about the work of this famous artist and developing a range of techniques. Picasso gives us many great opportunities to learn about abstract art.

As Design Technologists we will explore food groups and learn about the healthy foods to include in a picnic. We are planning to invite family and friends to a picnic on the school field towards the end of Term 1.

English

We will begin the term writing labels, lists and captions. We will also write recounts about our Summer Holiday and add these to our Time Capsule. Our focus story is *Asha in the Attic* and we will begin to write our own stories based on familiar settings. During poetry week we'll look at silly poems. Phonics and Spelling are taught daily following Letters and Sounds / Read, Write Inc.



Maths

In maths lessons we will be focusing on the following areas:
- Number and Place Value
- Addition and Subtraction



We revisit these areas many times over the course of the year following the Abacus Maths Scheme.

Science

Our science learning will be based on animals including humans – people and their pets. We will be observing creatures in the school grounds, photographing them and making sketches. We will learn about preferred habitats and plan an investigation. In the last week of term we will talk about and observe different pets. Key skills: Ask simple questions. Identify, group and classify. Use observations to suggest answers. Gather and record data.



Computing

Technology will be used purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content. We will also learn to recognise common uses of information technology beyond school.

PSHE

We explore our value of the term – CARE. We will be revising the school rules and agreeing rules for our classroom.

PE

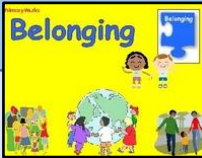
Outdoor PE is delivered by Ignite sports and Indoor PE will be Dance.
