Key Areas of Learning

As Geographers we will identify daily and seasonal weather patterns in the UK - this will also link with Science. We will then locate hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.

As Design Technologists we will continue to learn about food groups and will be baking individual traditional Christmas cakes to celebrate Christmas.

English

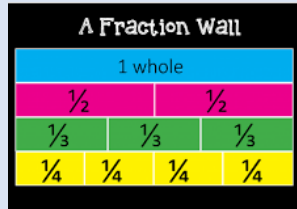
During Term 2 we will focus on the Christmas Story which will be cross curricular with RE. We will also be learning to write instructions and take part in lots of speaking and listening as we learn our lines and perform our Christmas Production.



We continue with Phonics and Spelling which are taught daily following Letters and Sounds / Read, Write Inc. Grammar is taught within the English lessons.

Maths

In maths lessons we will be focusing on the following areas:
- Number / number facts
- Multiplication
- Fractions
- 2D shape & data



We revisit these areas many times over the course of the year following the Abacus Maths Scheme.

Science – Seasonal changes, weather art

This term we will explore the four seasons and make a seasons collage. We'll be working outside to experience the wind and fly homemade kites.

Key skills:

Working scientifically, investigating and having meaningful outcomes are incorporated throughout. We learn to ask simple questions. Identify, group and classify. Use observations to suggest answers. Gather and record data.



Computing

This term the focus is digital media. The children will learn to turn written content into an electronic book (EBook). We will also introduce animation.

PSHE

Value of the term – RESPECT.

This will be explored through everyday school life and the way in which we treat others. We will be showing Respect as we learn about Remembrance Day.



PE

Outdoor PE is delivered by Ignite sports and Indoor PE will be Dance linked to our Christmas Production.

RE

Our focus is The Christmas Story.



Music – is delivered by a dedicated music teacher. This term the children will be learning new songs in preparation for our KS1 performance.
