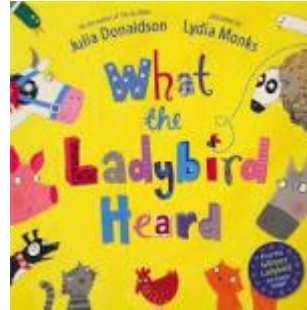

Why do Ladybirds have spots?

Welcome back. We hope you had a lovely break. This week we will be introducing our new topic all about mini beasts. We will begin by reading a favourite book "What the Ladybird Heard" looking carefully at rhyming words and adjectives (describing words) that the author uses to describe the animals. We will be describing a range of mini beasts, looking carefully at their features in order for us to draw our own representation.

Foundation

Phonics: We will continue reading straightforward two-syllable words and simple captions, as well as reading and spelling our tricky words.

Maths: This week in maths we will be looking at the days of the week, use language such as tomorrow, yesterday and today, to order events in our life. We will also look at how to tell the time, concentrating on o'clock, using analogue and digital clocks.

Bunnies

Phonics: This week we will be thinking carefully about rhyming words/strings, using the story of 'What the Ladybird Heard'. We will also be listening to lots of stories, using puppets to help retell our own versions.

Maths: We will continue working on recognising numbers, 1:1 correspondence and sing some counting songs
