

Why do Ladybirds have spots?

The children thoroughly enjoyed searching for, describing, and drawing minibeasts last weeks. The children surprised us with the interesting facts they already knew about minibeast. We will be using the school library and internet to research different minibeast to find out some more facts. We will be continuing our work on the story 'What the ladybird Heard', thinking about character and writing speech bubbles. We will also look carefully at the plan in the book and see if we can use directional language to give directions. The children enjoyed drawing minibeast so much last week we thought we would challenge them to paint mini beasts this week asking them to consider shape and colour.

### Foundation

**Phonics:** We will be practising reading and writing lots of sentences this week, applying the phases 3 phonemes and phase 4 tricky words. We are continuing to practise blending and segmenting longer words - listening carefully to words to make sure we hear all of the sounds in words.

**Maths:** This week we will practise adding and subtracting practically. We think about way to record using pictures and how to write formal calculations using the add, minus and equals signs.

### Bunnies

**Phonics:** We will be reading the stories K is for Kissing a Cool Kangaroo and Bumpus Jumpus Dinosaurumpus! We will be using these books to develop our understanding of rhyme and alliteration. We will be practising name writing.

**Maths:** We will continue working on recognising numbers, 1:1 correspondence and have a number hunt. We will learn to give directions.
