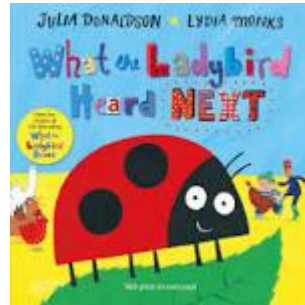

Why do Ladybirds have spots?

The children have really enjoyed reading "What the Ladybird Heard" so this week we will be introducing the sequel "What the Ladybird Heard Next" We will be predicting what happens next in the story by writing our own endings, introducing the term 'Onomatopoeia' (words that sound as they say ie oink or Miaow) and discussing similarities and differences between the two stories.

Foundation

Phonics: We will be practising reading and writing lots of sentences this week, applying the phases 3 phonemes and phase 4 tricky words. We are continuing to practise blending and segmenting longer words - listening carefully to words to make sure we hear all of the sounds in words. Please do continue to practise the tricky words that we sent home, it really is improving their writing.

Maths: In maths this week we will continue our work on addition and subtraction but we will be using coins to help solve word problems.

Phonics: This week we will continue looking at rhyming words. We will have fun playing parachute games.

Maths: We will sing '5 little speckled frogs' to help support our subtraction skills.
