

Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists** we will learn about animals. We will think about different habitats including micro habitats and learn that habitats provide the basic needs for animals and plants. We will explore different habitats on the school grounds. We will sort animals according to appearance and features and learn that some are carnivores, herbivores or omnivores. We will learn about simple food cycles and life cycles of some creatures and collect and record data. We will learn about Minibeasts and classification with our visitors from ZooLab.

English

This term we use the Text 'The Bog Baby' to inspire our story writing. Following our visit from ZooLab and using non-fiction texts about Minibeasts we research and write facts creating leaflets. We create a class book about Class 1 ready for the Reception children visiting us this term. Phonics and Spelling are taught daily following Letters and Sounds/Read, Write Inc. Grammar is taught within English

Maths

In maths lessons we will be focusing on the following areas:

- Number and Place Value
- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication and Division
- Fractions
- Money
- Measurement
- Properties of Shape
- Position and Direction
- Data

Each of the above are revisited many times over the course of the year following the Abacus

Art and DT

We finish the Noah's Ark picture that we are making, sewing on our felted pieces to the backdrop. We develop our observational drawing skills when observing and drawing mini beasts. We design a Bog Baby catcher. We make butterfly cupcakes to share on our open Minibeasts morning.

Computing

We revise our learning about e-safety. We use Ipads to take photographs of Minibeasts we find in the school grounds and research facts about Minibeasts. We take a beebot for a journey using our programming skills.

PSHE

We learn that we are all different and how to care for one another. We learn how to be safe around medicines. We also explore feelings about moving on to our next year groups and helping the Reception children feel welcome

We continue to have PE delivered by Ignite sports and Bartholomew PE teachers. This term we have our Sports Day
