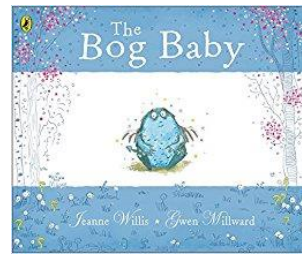


Wiggle and Crawl

Week 2

English:

We have started to use the text *The Bog Baby* to learn how to write sentences using adjectives and similes. We have also consolidated our learning in writing exclamatory sentences, (sentences that start with 'what' or 'how'). E.g. What a clever Bog Baby! This week we write instructions for catching a Bog Baby give advice on looking for Bog Babies and plan a new story about a Bog Baby.



Phonics and Read Write Inc.: Please look at the Read Write Inc. overview for this term. We are nearing the end of our phonics and RWI programme for this academic year. Children in year 1 will have their Statutory Phonics Check this week. Children from Reception will be joining Class 1 for phonics as part of our transition programme.

Maths:

Y1: Our student Miss Webb will be teaching Year 1 this week following the Abacus Maths Programme. This week the Year 1 children learn to recognise odd and even numbers; count in 2s, 5s and 10s, look for patterns; multiply by 2, 5, 10 by counting in groups/sets; find doubles to double 10 and related halves and half odd numbers up to 10.

Y2: This week year 2 demonstrate their knowledge of addition and subtraction, explaining their understanding through reasoning and problem solving. They explore addition through problem solving with odd and even numbers, demonstrate an understanding of remainders in some calculations, their ability to complete mental calculations and solving one and two step problems.
