



Wiggle and Crawl

Week 3

English: This week our student Miss Webb teaches English. She is using the text Hey Little Ant, a story about a tiny ant and whether he should be stepped on or not. The children will have opportunities to participate in role play and write a persuasive letter for or against the ant surviving! Children will focus on writing effective sentences with the use of joining words (e.g. but, so, because) to explain their reasons.



Phonics and Read Write Inc.: Please look at the Read Write Inc. overview for this term. We are nearing the end of our phonics and RWI programme for this academic year. Children in year 1 will have their Statutory Phonics Check this week. Children from Reception will be joining Class 1 for phonics as part of our transition programme.

Maths:

Y1: Children will consolidate their learning on odd and even numbers, doubling and halving and finding change for amounts.

Y2: Children learn to tell the time to the nearest five minutes. They count in 3s and recognise numbers in the 3 times table. They use arrays to solve multiplication and division problems. They count in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s and solve division problems using known facts.
