



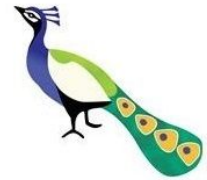

Dear Parents,

Before and After School clubs 4th January to 29th March 2018

In order that we can be certain of maintaining our usual daily provision of Before and After School Clubs next term we need to ask you to complete the form attached to let us know which clubs you would like your children to attend. The cost of the after school clubs will be £4 per hour unless they are run by an outside provider. Before School Club (open to Reception up to Year 6) will also cost £4 per hour this year, with the usual reduction for subsequent children to £3.

All clubs run from 3:15 - 4:15 except Stretch and Relax, which finishes at 4 pm.

Most of the clubs are self explanatory but here's some information about our more unusual clubs:

Cooking Club

Due to the popularity of this club, we had to operate a waiting list last term, so 6 places are already reserved. Mrs Hardy will be running the club next term.

Film Club

This will involve the children watching and reviewing movies and they will be provided with popcorn and a drink. It will be run by Mrs Crouch.

Stretch and Relax (3:15 - 4:00 pm only)

Similar to Pilates or Yoga for children. This club will be run by Miss Hutchins.

Cheerleading

As those who have been attending will know, Corey Hobbs is leaving the area so won't be able to take the club next term. We have sorted out another provider but as a result have to charge a little more per hour - £5.50. Unless we have 13 pupils signed up we won't be able to run this club, so please sign up! We'd hate to lose the club as we know how much the children enjoy it.

Choir

This club will be run by Mrs Kathy Stace who teaches music in school on Thursday afternoons in Classes One and Two. She will continue to run Recorder Club, but as a lunch-time club which will cost just £2 per session.

Quidditch

Mr Pooley will be running this club; he has been playing Quidditch at a high level for several years and is very excited to be teaching the game to children.

Science

Mr Laithwaite has had a successful operation and hopes to be up and running again with Science Club in January. This time it is the turn of Year 5 pupils to join in.
