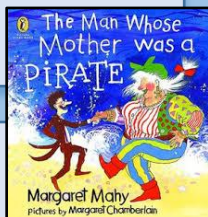

We will use this text in order to explore different settings. After reading and discussing **The Story Machine** we will create our own machines and write to explain their clever functions. Towards the end of term we will discuss personal responses to poems and perform and recite some poetry in front of an audience.

## Letters and Sounds

We continue daily Phonics and Spelling which are taught following Letters and Sounds / Read, Write Inc. Grammar is taught within English lessons.

## Geography: Oceans and Continents

By interpreting maps and locating important countries and continents we will learn to name and identify the Seven Continents and Five Oceans. We will also use more detailed maps to find out about Europe, the Mediterranean, Africa and South America.



## Key Areas of Learning

### Maths

This term the focus will be on:

- Number and Fractions
- Addition and Subtraction
- 3D Shape & Time
- Multiplication and Division
- Money, Number



We have visited these areas many times over the course of this year.

**Computing: E-safety** - Through the creation of a cyber-safety rainbow the children will learn the meaning of staying safe online, who to go to for help and how to safely enjoy the many opportunities that the internet has to offer.

### Science / Art

#### Habitats and Homes / Collage

Drawing on our knowledge of habitats we will design a bug hotel and incorporate many different micro-habitats to encourage a variety of guests. We will explore and compare the differences between things that are living/dead and things that have never been alive. We will identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants and how they depend on each other. In Art we will be making collages to depict different habitats and homes.



**PE:** Athletics. The children will have the opportunity to participate in a range of track and field events including throwing foam javelins, jumping hurdles, short and long distance running as well as relays all great preparation for Sports Day!



**PSHE:** Value of the term – EXCELLENCE. It's not only about winning, but about taking part and making a commitment to become better at something, beating your personal best and achieving a goal.

### RE – Judaism Do we need shared special places? / Shabbat

We will explore the significance and role of the synagogue and become aware of the role of the home for people of the Jewish faith.
