Your Child's Learning Journey

When your child starts Early Years Foundation Stage at Stanton Primary School your child will be given a Learning Journey which forms part of their Early Years Foundation Stage profile. This will be used by your child's Key person to assess and record progression and achievement against the early learning goals. The Learning Journey will contain reports, observations, photographs, planned next steps, wow slips and samples of work

Your input is equally important to us to help meet your child's needs and we would invite you to make entries in the learning journey regarding your child's development at home and any next steps you feel are important that we should aim to plan for. This information can be used by the Key Person to help support your child's learning and development. You can add your comments and feedback in relation to the observations or could include 'wow' slips or attach a special piece of work your child has completed at home. We would prefer that children are not left to make their own entries in the Learning Journal. Learning Journeys will be kept in the classroom so please speak to a member of the team if you would like to see them. **You are welcome to take your child's learning Journey home, however we do ask that you return them as soon as possible as Key people will be required to continually add to the Learning Journey to build a record of your child's progress and help them plan for their next steps each term at Pre-school**

When your child leaves EYFS you will be given your child's Learning Journey as a keepsake.

We would like you to start the Learning Journey at home with your child by completing the first page which is an introduction sheet. The Learning Journey should then be returned to Pre-school.
