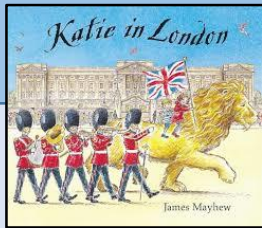
Key Areas of Learning

As **Historians** we will learn about Florence Nightingale. The children will find out about some of the main events in Florence Nightingale's life and be able to sequence them correctly. Using pictures, books and computing they will research information and recount her story.

As **Design Technologists** we will be baking Valentine Biscuits. This term we will be using our Maths skills of weighing and measuring in order to measure the relevant ingredients accurately. We will learn more about imperative verbs and how to use these correctly as we write this recipe for our future reference.

English

During Term 3 we will be looking at tales from other cultures. The text *Katie in London* will be used as a model for our own story writing. We will also learn how to recite and perform poetry.



Maths

This term, focus will be on:
- Number, Addition & Subtraction
- Money
- Weight, Time, Position and Direction
- Multiplication and Division

Science – Everyday Materials: Brilliant Builders!

This term we will rise to the challenge of exploring different materials and sorting them into groups. We will consider what it would be like if tables were made of jelly or chairs were chocolate. Linked to our topic we will make our own models of famous landmarks in London.

Key skills:

- asking simple questions and recognising that they can be answered in different ways
- close observation, using simple equipment
- performing simple tests
- identifying and classifying
- using observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions
- gathering and recording data to answer questions.



PSHE: Value of the term – **EQUALITY**. The children will learn that equality is about ensuring individuals are treated fairly and equally, no matter their race, gender, age, disability or religion.
